building its industries, the Commercial club of Salt Lake will issue a call in a few days for a two days' convention of representatives of the various organizations in every city and town in Utah.

Three representatives from each of the thirty or more commercial and industrial organizations in Utah cities and towns will be asked to meet in the Commercial club on Dec. 10 and 11.

The call, which explains the whole idea, is as follows: "A convention of representatives of the commercial and industrial organizations of the state of Utah is hereby called to meet in the Commercial club, Salt Lake City, Utah, Dec. 10, 1908.

Objects of the Convention. "This convention is called for the purpose of creating a state league of commercial and industrial organizations, the duty of which shall be to advance by all legitimate means the growth and prosperity of the state of Utah.

"The purposes of this league shall be to advance, by social intercourse and friendly exchange of views, the commercial prosperity and growth of the state of Utah; to promote uniformity in the customs and usages of producers, manufacturers and merchants; seek remunerative markets for home products, foster capital and protect labor, mutually interested in each other's welfare; and that section will be one of the busiest in the city.

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The board of directors of the M. & M. will meet Monday evening in the Chamber of Commerce at 8 o'clock, as had been originally decided upon, and the decision will then be reached as to the best time to hold the mass meeting of the citizens. In the meantime, representatives of the M. & M. will make a canvass among representative men in the business district and find whether it would be advisable to push the project of building a new home for the organization.

VETOES HALL RESOLUTION. Mayor Says It Would Give Police Department Too Much Power. The resolution of Councilman Hall, which directs the chief of police to refuse to endorse any application for license in a saloon where there are stalls, did not meet with the approval of Mayor Bradford, and it was returned to the city council with the notation that its terms placed too much responsibility upon the police department and gave it too much power. Mayor Bradford suggested that if the council desired to take action in this regard it should adopt a resolution similar to that offered by Mr. Stewart last Monday, by which Mr. Hall's resolution is a substitute.
