PRISONER GOES BACK TO BUTTE

Fight Against Extradition Fails and Sheriff Starts With Man.

HARD FIGHT IS MADE SHERIFF DECLARES HE WAS THREATENED IN THIS CITY.

John Patten's fight against extradition to Butte, Mont., where he and two companions are charged with robbing Marcus Hezak, a Butte business man, of \$500, proved fruitless yesterday when Judge M. L. Ritchie of the Third district court refused to set aside the warrant issued by Governor William Spry on Friday, and Patten was turned over to Under Sheriff Mike Murray of Silver Bow county, Montana.

The ruling of Judge Ritchie was made shortly after 10 o'clock, and Patten was taken north on the Oregon Short Line at 2:25 p. m.

That Patten feared returning to Butte was shown in the fact that he nearly broke down when Judge Ritchie refused to uphold his writ for habeas corpus, which was sworn out after Governor Spry honored the requisition from Governor Edwin L. Norris of Montana and issued his warrant for Patten to be turned over to the Butte officials.

Patten hesitated for a few moments in the court room, but was then hustled away by Under Sheriff Murray and taken to the depot.

Patten's attorneys asked for a stay of execution for five days, in which time to prepare an appeal to the Supreme court, but this was denied them by Judge Ritchie, as Patten is wanted now in Butte for the robbery.

Judge Ritchie said that the amount of the appeal bond, but Patten's attorneys were unable to raise this amount and their client was taken away.

Hundreds Search in Vain for Boy Who Drowned Yesterday.

Gasoline launches with drag hooks raked the bottom of the river for hours. Men in diving suits went into all the deep holes, but all to no avail, the body could not be found.

The point where the little form disappeared in the river is filled with many deep holes. The current is exceptionally strong, so that the body was probably swept into one of the holes, where it became lodged and afterwards was covered with sand.

Went Swimming. Clarence, with his brothers Melvin, aged 15; Walter, aged 13; and Willard, aged 9, went to the river about 9 o'clock Saturday morning.

UTAH BARBERS WILL OBEY THE LAWS

State Board of Examiners Submits Gratifying Report to Governor.

FEW CASES OF DISEASE REGULATIONS ARE STRICT—LIST OF INSPECTORS.

The state board of barber examiners yesterday submitted its annual report to the governor. The report shows that during the entire year it has been unnecessary to make a single arrest in order to enforce the law.

The report shows that there are 106 barber shops in Utah, employing 555 journeymen barbers and seventy-five apprentices. In Salt Lake there are 257 barbers and thirty-nine apprentices, working in seventy-six barber shops.

The receipts from the examinations and licenses issued were \$141,45, exceeding the expenditures for the year by \$3.65.
