

NO GROUND HOG SHADOW

Weather Bureau Says No Prospect of Animal Seeing His Image Here Today.

Some little difficulty is expected throughout Utah by the railroads because of the heavy snowfall of yesterday and last night. No delays in train schedules were reported yesterday, but if the heavy fall continues considerable trouble is anticipated.

The storm yesterday was unexpected, as conditions of Monday were such as to have produced perfect weather for yesterday and today.

No rain today, as predicted by the weather department. Although Section Director A. H. Thilless does not believe in the possibility of a general fall of the groundhog and its shadow, yet he stated yesterday that if such a story were true, weather for Salt Lake would have good prospects for at least 24 hours.

"For the city will be overhung by snow for at least 24 hours, that is, the truth in the ground hog theory, whatever, according to the weather man, means for us here."

Snow fell during the last 48 hours over the whole of the western and northwestern Canadian provinces. In general, the temperature is reported throughout the territory west of the Mississippi river, to be above zero.

PIOCHE ON BRANCH LINE

Nevada Town Will Not Be On New Portion of Salt Lake Route.

General Manager R. E. Wells of the Salt Lake route, returning to Los Angeles after a tour of inspection of the damaged portion of the line in Meadow Valley, has given the impression that Pioche will not be on the main line when construction is recommenced.

"Nothing is known, but we are daily expecting Chief Engineer Tilton and Arthur McGuire in with the reports of the damage to the line in the Meadow Valley section. There is a branch line there now, and that probably is all that will be built."

"We will probably build the shortest, easiest line in spite of commercial interests, and while there are some old surveys in the Pioche country, we have not looked into them."

"When we hear the final report of the engineers we will be in a position to point out our route in the city of Salt Lake."
