Republican Rallies Over State to Give Campaign a Whirlwind Finish.

STARTING WITH MURRAY

Closing Week Brim Full of Speeches and Gatherings, Beginning at the Smelter City.

Republicans Plan Active Work to Get Out Remainder of Vote.

EIGHT THOUSAND OFF LIST

Attempt of Tribune Party to Register Vagrants and Floaters Will Be Frustrated.

With a big Republican rally at Murray tonight the closing week of the campaign will be ushered in, and it will be a busy week, Thursday night alone having eleven Republican rallies...

Tomorrow is the last day of registration and the agents will be busy from 8 a. m. until 3 p. m. Republican workers will be on duty in each district all day to assist in getting out the full registration and wherever necessary, carriers will be available...

The biggest rally of the campaign will be held Friday night in the Salt Lake theatre. State and national issues will be most prominent at this rally. Governor William Spry, Senator Reed Smoot, Senator George Sutherland and Congressman Joseph Howell will be the speakers...

Rydahl will speak at Brigham City. At Draper, Mrs. Susa Y. Gates, Mrs. George Sutherland and Mrs. Joseph Howell will speak. The Scandinavian rally at Ogden hall will have Governor Spry, O. W. Carlson and other speakers, including Senator Smoot.
