




CAPITAL PRIZE DISTRICT NO. 1

CLOSING RULES

Of The Logan Republican Gift Campaign.

The final count of votes that will determine the winners in The Logan Republican's Circulation Campaign will be in charge of the following prominent Logan business men who have been requested to act as Judges.

- DR. I. S. SMITH
- WILLIAM HOWELL
- JOHN H. CHRISTIANSEN

These gentlemen will take possession of the sealed ballot box on Saturday night at nine o'clock and NO ONE CONNECTED WITH THE REPUBLICAN will have any hand in counting the votes. The winners of the prizes will be announced after the count is completed.

CLOSING RULES OF THE CONTEST

The ballot box will be locked and sealed Thursday morning and the keys will be placed in possession of the Judges. All campaign collections secured by candidates from Thursday morning until the closing hour of the contest, nine o'clock Saturday night, are to be placed in envelopes, together with the report sheet covering the subscriptions, and deposited in the sealed ballot box by each candidate personally.

All votes, certificates held in reserve by candidates are to be placed in envelopes and deposited in the sealed ballot box. This ruling also applies to anyone wishing to subscribe to The Republican and have the votes credited to a candidate in the race.

All vote certificates and all business secured in the last three days of the contest by ALL candidates MUST be in the ballot box by nine p. m. next Saturday, or they will not count.

No checks will be accepted during the last three days of the campaign. If personal checks are deposited in the ballot box they will not be counted. Postoffice money orders, express money orders, certified checks, gold or silver and currency, will be accepted; also Liberty bonds.

The best way for the candidates, this week, is to have checks made to them personally, cash same, and deposit money with report in the sealed ballot box.

Placing actual currency in your envelope is the safest plan if you want all your votes counted.

If in doubt concerning the above rulings, then ask questions until you fully understand.

Under the above closing rules of the campaign NO ONE will know how many votes any other competitor may have.

By the above arrangement no favoritism can be shown, and there can be no fairer way of closing the contest.

It will be the case of the best worker winning. Not even the attaches of this office have any idea of how the candidates stand, or who will win.

The voting from Thursday until the judges open the box for the final counting Saturday night WILL BE BLIND IN EVERY SENSE OF THE WORD. NO ONE WILL HAVE ANY IDEA AS TO WHO THE WINNERS WILL BE UNTIL THE ANNOUNCEMENT IS MADE BY THE COMMITTEE OF JUDGES.

If everything is not quite clear to any candidate, or to any friend of any candidate, THEN ASK QUESTIONS UNTIL YOU UNDERSTAND EVERY POINT in the closing rules of this contest.

Votes for the last publication of the standings MUST be in this office NOT LATER than noon Wednesday, November 19th, to appear in Thursday's paper. No exceptions will be made. The standings as they appear in Thursday's issue of The Republican will be the same in the paper Saturday. No changes will be made in the interval.

The judges will take the standings in The Republican of Thursday on which to base the final count to determine the winners. All subscriptions and certificates in the ballot box will be tabulated by the judges and added to the newspaper standings, thereby arriving at a grand total and establishing the winners of the gifts.

Remember, the VOTING IN THE LAST THREE DAYS WILL BE BLIND. NO ONE, NOT EVEN THE CAMPAIGN MANAGER, WILL HAVE ANY IDEA OF HOW THE CANDIDATES STAND, OR WHO WILL WIN.
