

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

EGGS IN THE WINTER

ONLY WAY TO MAKE HEN KEEP-ING PROFITABLE.

Woman of Experience Tells What is Necessary to Keep the Occupants of the Poultry Yard at Work During the Cold Months.

Those whose hens do not lay during the winter months, would be better off without hens. This seems like laying down the law, but it is nevertheless a fact. Those who keep hens because it is a pleasure need look for no other profit if they are amused; but when chickens are kept with the hope that they will put money into the pocket of their owners, they must be made to lay through the winter, while eggs bring prices. How can I make them lay? is a question often put. Now there are a few birds that will not lay through cold weather, no matter how good the care, and if the breeder hap-

pens on this kind, he may rise early and lie down late and eat the bread of carefulness, also feeding it to his flock and not a single egg will be his reward. At the same time good birds want good care to make them "shell their eggs out." The first point needful is to pick out laying types among early hatched pullets, or even hens. It is not too late to cull over the flock even now. A laying type is even more important than a laying strain. There are disappointments in breeding from laying strains. I have never come across a disappointment in a laying type of hen.

The heads of a good layer, will be very sharply cut, the neck arched, the eye above all bright and sparkling. The under part of the head very clean cut, and the whole set of the head and neck a little bit like that of a race horse. These two cuts will illustrate the type I mean to perfection. I sketched the two heads from two Buff Orpington hens in my own yard. They both at separate shows won first prizes as pullets. They are bred from an exceptional laying strain, and are the same age. Both have been treated exactly alike. No. 1 lays few eggs during the year. No. 2 lays nearly an egg a day, winter and summer, as nearly as it is possible for a hen to do so.

The next important step is sheds—open sheds facing south with good roofs and deep enough to prevent snow or rain drifting right in. The front should be covered either with wire netting or slats, so that the fowls can be shut in during wet weather. Fresh air is a great essential for egg production. If the birds are put into close, warm houses during the night and allowed out into the cold morning air, they become chilled and eggs are out of the question. A cosy house, air tight, as to cracks and floor can be built in the corner of the shed. Now as to food, where only table eggs are required, a very concentrated diet may be given; a hot mash

In the morning, consisting of bran, meal, cornmeal, ground oats, boiled potatoes, peameal, barley meal and shorts. A little black pepper may be added, also granulated meat, every other morning a teaspoonful of good poultry spice per hen should be added. It should all be given hot, one quart is enough for every eight hens.—Mrs. C. B., in Montreal Herald.

Weight of Wool in a Bin.

J. G.—Is there any rule whereby one could ascertain the weight of wool in a bin? The wool is packed in fairly hard.

Ans.—No such rule as is suggested has ever come to our attention, nor is it likely that such a rule exists for the reason that wool varies in weight according to its firmness, cleanliness and the closeness with which it is packed. If the wool is in fleeces a fairly accurate estimate should be arrived at by weighing a dozen or more of the average ones and calculating from the average weight of these what the entire number of fleeces will weigh.
