Buried by Life Preservers.
Life preservers came near being the death of two men in Long Island City yesterday afternoon, says a New York dispatch. The men were in a buckboard automobile and were in a hurry to catch a thirty-fourth street ferry boat. The machines rushed down Borden avenue and swung around the corner, at the Long Island railroad station, on two wheels.

As the automobile shot across the plaza in front of the ferry entrance a large baggage truck, heaped high with life preservers, came along, pushed by half a dozen porters. The baggage truck struck the automobile amidships and the load of life preservers tumbled on top of the two men in the automobile. They shouted for help, but their cries were quickly stifled by the life preservers.

A big crowd saw the accident, and when they had recovered from laughing the two men were rescued. They escaped with crushed hats and a few scratches. They declined to give their names.

"The Head of Spite."
A huge, hideous face of a woman is fixed on a house in Berlin, and is known as "The Head of Spite." The Emperor William I. had it erected as a warning against rancorous ill will. The Emperor stopped one day at a blacksmith's to have his horse's shoe refixed. Next door was a rival blacksmith, and the daughter of this man of muscle put her tongue out and distorted her face, which was never very pretty, with a horrible grin, in order to show her contempt for the King. His Majesty took no notice of the insult at the time, but the next day he ordered a well known German sculptor to produce in wood a monstrous face of a woman with a tongue lolling out of the mouth. The Emperor himself superintended the fixing of this strange ornament above the doorway of the blacksmith's shop, where the irred woman resided, and there it has remained ever since.

A Valuable Book.
In the library of the palace of the Rajah of Ulwar, a city in India, there is a manuscript book called "The Gulistan," which is claimed to be the most valuable volume in India.

The librarian insists that it is worth five hundred thousand rupees, which is equivalent to about a hundred and seventy thousand dollars, and declares that the actual cost of the gold used in illuminating it was more than fifty thousand dollars. It is a modern manuscript copy of a religious poem, made in 1848 by a German scribe at the order of the Maharajah Bani Singh. The miniatures and other pictures were painted by a native artist at Delhi, and the ornamental scroll work upon the margins of the pages and the initial letters were done by a resident of Ulwar.

Tattooed Women.
There are two sorts of tattooing in use among the women of the Congo. One is common to all the members of the same tribe, and indicates the origin and birthplace of the subject. It is an infallible and perpetual certificate of birth and nationality. The other sort of tattooing is simply fantasy and coquetry. But among certain tribes there is a third kind. The women record upon their bodies the epochs of their existence. A horizontal line marks marriage, oblique lines the birth of children, a vertical line weaving, another line change of residence. Thus the autobiography of the woman is written upon her person, and is regarded with pride if it is full of events.

America's First Iron Bridge.
Up to 1840 there were no iron bridges in the United States except suspension bridges. In which iron links were used in the cables and suspenders, the floor system being of wood. The first bridge in America consisting of iron throughout was built in 1840 by Earl Trumbull over the Erie canal in the village of Frankfort, N. Y.

Many Stitches in Quilts.
A Cambridge (England) lady finds on careful computation that two quilts which she has just made contain about 2,334,199 stitches. In one garment there are 1,322 stitches in each of the 1,080 pieces, making a total, with border work, of 1,618,023.

Watch Kept Time Under Water.
Ray Jenkins lost his watch overboard in fifteen feet of water at Bakers Island, Mass. Two days later Frank Turner found the watch while diving, and examination showed that it was in perfect running order.

Whole Town to Be Moved.
Practically every building in the little lumbering town of Herring, Potter county, Pa., will be moved to Shingle House by rail. The distance is six miles. The work of transporting the buildings began a few days ago.
