

URGENT DAY IN N. Y. STOCKS

Rally at Close Succeeds Varied Declines of Mid-day Session

NEW YORK, April 20.—Pressure against shares recently in speculative favor was resumed at the opening of today's stock market. Selling seemed to be the result of professional speculators based on the uncertain money situation.

Observing the little resistance was offered to their first attack, the shorts extended their operations, especially in the more vulnerable issues, these included Mexican and Pan-American Petroleum, Baldwin and American Locomotive, American Vanadium, Bethlehem and Republic Steels, Studebaker and Chandler Motors, Stromberg, Atlantic-Gulf and United Fruit, American Woolen, Hide and Leather preferred and Sumatra Tobacco at extreme declines of 3 to 10 points.

Substantial rallies succeeded, the decline of call money to 5 per cent, the short interest, however, remained heavy. Recoveries of 2 to 7 points were made by General Motors, Crucible Steel, Baldwin Locomotive, Mexican Petroleum, Texas company and Hide and Leather preferred. Trading became quiet on the rebound.

STOCKS STRONG, UPWARD TREND

Sells and Keystone Lead Utah Mines in Activity on Exchange

The tendency shown in mining stocks today on the Salt Lake Stock & Mining Exchange was a little stronger, with the trend in the majority of the stocks upward. This was particularly noticeable in Sells and Keystone, the former opening at 200 and advancing to 212 1/2 on the first call, but weakened again before the close of the day, closing with only 205 1/2 bid and 212 asked, while the latter was as high as \$1.05, it closing strong with \$1.02 1/2 bid for it. Tintic Standard which showed strength yesterday weakened to a certain extent today, changing hands as low as \$4.80 and closing with only this price bid for it.

Antelope Star changed hands at 1c. Alta Tunnel brought 9 1/2c. Eureka Lily was off a little, changing hands at 26 1/2c. Columbus Rexall sold at 62c. Gold Chain brought 7c.
