FIGHTERS READY FOR BIG CONTEST

Dempsey and Miske Complete Training for Labor Day Title Event

BENTON HARBOR, Mich., Sept. 1.—Jack Dempsey, world's champion heavyweight, and Billy Miske, challenger, today entered on the final three days of training in preparation for their ten round heavy weight championship contest here next Monday afternoon.

Dempsey plans to gradually cut down his work with the gloves and probably will only go six rounds this afternoon. Miske also will start to taper off in his training, finishing up with two rounds.

Benton Harbor is beginning to wake up, rather, the out-of-town visitors are arriving to wake the town up to the fact that it has a heavyweight championship bout on its hands.

Dempsey, who boxed eight full rounds yesterday, declared today that he was thoroughly satisfied with his condition, and that he felt better than he did at Toledo a year ago, when he had reached the same stage of his training for Jess Willard.

Dempsey is ready. "I know I am ready to step the full ten rounds at top speed," the champion said, "but I don't think it will go that long. I made up my mind yesterday to let myself out as early as possible. I will be glad to stop when I feel tired and my mind was good. I don't know what I'll do with the remainder of my training. It will depend largely on how I feel from day to day."
