GREEN TOMATO Mince MEAT

- 1 peck green tomatoes
1 cup chopped suet
2 cups chopped apples
2 lemons
1 cup vinegar
1 pound seedless raisins
1 pound seeded raisins
2 pounds sugar
1/2 cup crystallized ginger
1-2 cup effron
1 tablespoon nutmeg
1 tablespoon salt

Wash tomatoes. Chop and drain off juice. Pour over boiling water, let stand a few minutes and drain. Do this three times. Put in preserving kettle with apples, but there is such a risk of great waste that it seems to me greater economy to use those that are not mature enough to ripen in a week's time.

1-2 lemons
