

# XMAS GREETING FOR TEACHERS

### Supt. Hopkins Sends Notice to Pedagogues on Occasion of Holiday.

"I wish that the compensation of teachers, principals, supervisors, were somewhat more commensurate with the duties and responsibilities of the position they occupy," says Superintendent W. Karl Hopkins in his Christmas greetings to the teachers of Ogden.

Superintendent Hopkins says: "May every day be a happy day. May good health follow along your way.

"And every year a blessing. And fortune your pockets caressing." "We have one more thrill before we look arms with winter. The holiday season is the time of all the year when the opportunity comes to gain happiness by giving it. This is the best philosophy of all minds of all time.

"May I take this opportunity to greet you, as nearly personally as I may, and remind you that the world would not go on without your work, and that your work is better done in these times than it has ever been done, in scope or intensity?

"May the holiday time bear you a beautiful and pleasant retrospect of the past year. May you have joy in all your friends at the Christmas time and courage in your heart to face the New Year. And above all, remember that each individual's effort to make his work a success is being recognized and appreciated.

### HIS CHRISTMAS WISH.

"If I were told that my Christmas wish for 1920 were to come true, it would be for the boys and girls of Ogden, and it would be this: "I wish that every boy and girl in Ogden could sit at the feet of teachers whose lives are consecrated to the upbuilding of character and the outpouring of wisdom, thereby emulating the example of the Great Teacher.

"I wish that every teacher, principal, supervisor, superintendent and board member throughout the length and breadth of our country, were guided in all he says and does by one axiom: The schools are for the children.

"I wish that individually and collectively we could all remember that the hope of Ogden and of America lies in a happy and educated citizenry who are in the schools today.

"I wish that we could all remember that an engine is built to do a certain definite work, but no matter how well polished the fittings, how popular the engineer, how good the coal, the wheels will not turn, the engine will not do the work for which it was designed until the steam reaches the machinery. No matter how beautiful the school building, how complete the equipment, how high or how low the tax rate, the schools are not doing their work until the child has been reached by or through the teacher.

### HAPPY SCHOOL.

"I wish that we could all remember that a good school is a happy school. One of the best teachers in a large city said of her principal: "In order to keep our school in the lead he drives us so hard that we are really unkind to the children. We can't give them any kind of the pleasures of school life. We just drive, and drive, and drive. If a boy is slow or delicate or has some duties to perform, I am obliged to make life a burden to him and school a torment. Hawthorne school get ahead of us, although the children come from very different homes." A school cannot be happy when the teacher is disheartened or worried.

"I wish that everybody could be a little more thoughtful of the teacher's schedule. It is important to make the recitation and commercial whole developed in regular sequence. Interruption is a pedagogical crime. Yet, too often is this principle forgotten or broken for the mere convenience of those in authority.

"I wish that the American boys and girls may receive most generously from the outpourings of the New Year the things in life that count and are worth while.

"Finally, I wish that "Peace on earth good will toward men" be and abide with all teachers, pupils, and peoples forevermore.
