Notice is hereby given by the Board of Commissioners of Ogden City, Utah, of the intention of said Board of Commissioners to make the following described improvements, to-wit: To create both sides of Henniger avenue between Twelfth and Thirteenth streets, the north side of Twelfth street between Washington avenue and Engineer's station 144-41.6 "B," the south side of Twelfth street between Washington avenue and Engineer's station 147-48.6 "B," and the west side of Farley avenue between Twelfth St. and Engineer's station 205-197.0 "A" as a sidewalk district and to construct thereon, including all intersections, concrete sidewalks five feet in width and four inches in thickness, except at driveways where the thickness of the sidewalk shall be six inches, the removal of all trees, fences, poles, buildings, etc., where necessary to the building of culverts, irrigation, and drainage systems, together with the necessary grading therefor, and all other things necessary to complete the whole in a proper manner according to plans, specifications, and profiles on file in the office of the City Engineer, and to defray the whole of the cost and expense of the abovesaid portion thereof by a levy of a special tax to be assessed upon the lots or pieces of ground within the following described district, being the district to be affected or benefited by such improvement, namely: All the land lying between the outer boundary lines of said streets and a line drawn fifty feet back from and parallel to said outer boundary lines on both sides of Henniger avenue between Twelfth and Thirteenth streets, the north side of Twelfth street between Washington avenue and Engineer's station 144-41.6 "B," the south side of Twelfth street between Washington avenue and Engineer's station 147-48.6 "B," and the west side of Farley avenue between Twelfth street and Engineer's station 205-197.0 "A," being part of the Northeast quarter of Section 21, part of the Northwest quarter of Section 21, and part of the northeast quarter of section 20, all in Township 6 north, Range 1 west, Salt Lake Base and Meridian, United States survey, all within the corporate limits of Ogden City, Utah.
