KOLCHAK MOVES HEADQUARTERS TO IRKUTSK OMSK, Thursday, Nov. 12.—Via Novo Nikolaevsk.—(By The Associated Press)—The staff headquarters of the all-Russian government armies have been established at Tatarskaja, whitener Admiral Kolchak will go presently but expects to proceed shortly after to Irkutsk, from which point he will direct the affairs of the all-Russian government. The retreat of the Siberian army was carried out in orderly fashion and being virtually out of contact with the Bolshevik forces, there was little fighting. The cavalry and artillery are concentrating at Omsk. A constant stream of peasant carts bearing refugees has been passing through Omsk. The correspondent interviewed a number of them who said they probably would freeze on the roads but preferred to take chances on this rather than to live under Bolshevik rule. The gold reserve of the Omsk banks has been removed eastward. Although the economy is only fifty miles distant the newspapers contain publication, filled with anti-Bolshevik propaganda. NOVO NIKOLAEVSK, Russia, Thursday, Nov. 13.—(By The Associated Press)—Ernest L. Harris, American consul general at Omsk, plans to leave November 17 for Irkutsk, there to re-establish personal contact with Admiral Kolchak's all-Russian government.
