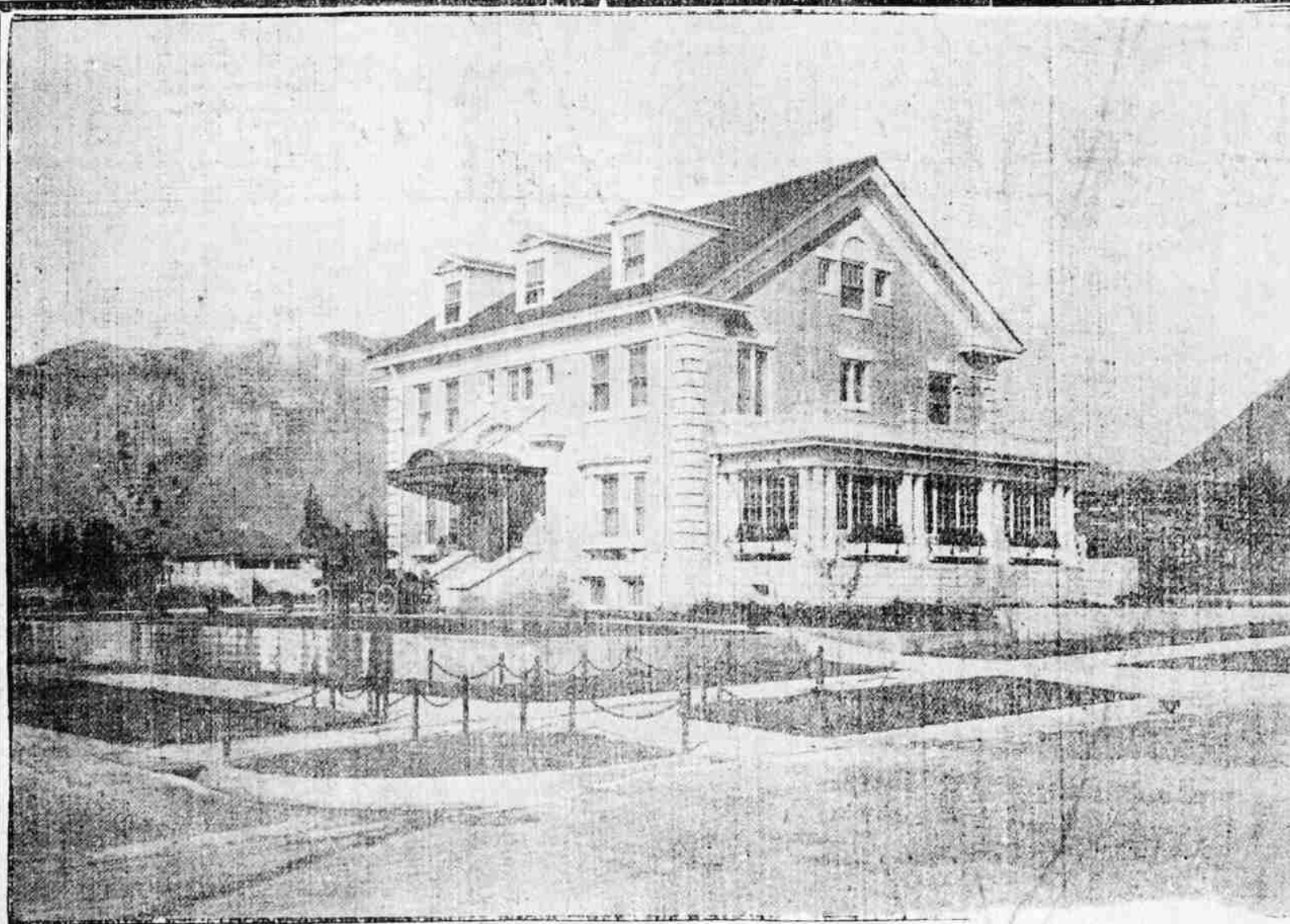

Beautiful Homes to Be Seen in City of Ogden

PROSPERITY AND THRIFT SEEN IN THE RESIDENT DISTRICT WHERE WELL CONSTRUCTED HOUSES AND WELL KEPT LAWNS ARE MANY--MAJORITY OF THE PEOPLE HAVE THEIR OWN HOMES--SMALL ORCHARDS AND GARDENS IN PARTS OF THE CITY--BRICK AND CEMENT USED IN CONSTRUCTION OF BUILDINGS.

It has not been a long time since the first home was built in Ogden and there are people in Ogden who remember it. When those old inhabitants look back, they are amazed at the progress the city has made from the time the first humble home was built up to the present when mansions like the above are common.

Since that first humble log house was constructed Ogden has been noted for its homes and the "homey" feeling that is radiated to all visitors. Ogden could be truly called a city of homes and the homes are mostly owned by those occupying them. Some of them, it is true, are humble, but they have an added value when the fact is taken into consideration that they are the result of much economy and sacrifice on the part of the owners. Many laboring men are living in their own homes in Ogden who would through circumstances be compelled to live in tenement houses were they in a larger city.

A city can easily be judged by its homes. A visit through the principal streets in the residence district of a city will quickly lead the prospective resident to decide whether to remain or seek some other city in which to live. The character of the inhabitants is indicated by the condition of their houses. A shiftless worker will permit weeds to grow in his front lot where a beautiful lawn would indicate his industry and likewise an unpainted home is a criterion of the ability of the occupant. If a city is filled with undesirable residents, betokened by the condition of their dwellings, then that city cannot call out for new citizens with any success.

A walk through the streets of Ogden indicates the industry, pride and general wealth of the inhabitants.

Lawns and flower gardens occupy the front yards of nearly every house in the city and there are few houses but what always look neat through the careful application of paint. A majority of the houses, it is true, are not mansions, but an inspection will indicate that the city is composed of moderately wealthy citizens with very few poor people and several mansions like the above indicate that we have our share of the wealthy.

The difference in cost of materials is so slight in this city that most dwellings are built of brick or cement instead of wood. With the coming in of the bungalow style of architecture, however, the number of frame houses is increasing and the city is being dotted with these neat homes.

Ogden may well feel proud of her residence districts, for the houses are neater, the yards cleaner and the indications of prosperity are greater as displayed by the houses than in any other city of the same size in the west. We should also feel proud of the fact that so many laboring men own their own homes and that we have no poorly ventilated, unsanitary tenements in which to house the poorer classes, as is the case in a number of cities. Ogden is still so broad and the price of land is so reasonable that nearly everyone finds it possible to own their own home and the atmosphere of content is more marked where such is the case.

Many who enjoy a small orchard or garden near their homes have found it possible to attain their desires. Within a short distance of the shopping district are several lots large enough for an orchard after a house has been built. They enjoy all advantages of the country while living in a city and their spare hours are spent in the enjoyable work of raising products of the soil with much benefit to their health as well as increasing their monetary income.
