FIVE MEN ARE DEAD SEVEN BADLY HURT

Shawnee, Okla., Dec. 24.—Five men are believed to be dead and seventeen were injured as the result of the explosion of an engine in the shops of Chicago, Rock Island & Pacific railroad here today.

The explosion occurred at the noon hour, when most of the employees of the shops were at lunch.

The explosion wrecked the repair shops and buried pieces of wrecked machinery several rods. Windows all over town were shattered.

The body of Kerr was found on Main street, three blocks away. Fragments of the body of Johns were found on roofs of adjoining buildings.

Kerr and Johns were working on the engine when the explosion occurred. The firemen most seriously injured were taken to the company hospital at McAlester.

A rescue crew were at work tonight digging for twelve men believed to be pinned beneath the mass of twisted iron and splintered timbers.
