

**WEEKLY CROP REPORT IS VERY ENCOURAGING.**

Friday, Saturday and Sunday were warm days. The mean temperature for the week, however, only averaged about on degree per day above the normal. The maximum temperatures ranged from 80 to 90 degrees, minimum temperatures from 50 to 70 degrees. Thunder showers, which were mostly very light, occurred on Tuesday and Sunday. Wednesday and Thursday were clear. The rainfall was generally considerably deficient, and the sun-shine was about normal.

The high temperatures were favorable for crops, especially for corn, which has made rapid growth. It is generally being worked the second and third time; the stand and color is good, and the prospects are promising. Wheat and rye have improved greatly during the last four weeks, and will make a much better yield than expected, although considerably below the average; the harvest will generally begin later than usual. New meadows are good, but old meadows are weedy; a good hay crop is promised. Clover is being harvested. Oats and potatoes are doing finely and will make good crops. Gardens have made good growth. Pastures are doing well, and stock is in fine condition. Buckwheat continues to be sown. Millet and cow peas are doing well. Apples continue to fall, and the prospects are poor for fair yield. Peaches and pears are fairly promising, and cherries are rather scarce.
