JAPANESE REPULSED

Mukden, Sept. 21.—The Japanese are pushing northward. At the outposts together with points around Yen Tai, where the Russians are concentrated for a strong stand there is heavy fighting in skirmishes and a battle is imminent.

St. Petersburg, Sept. 21.—Kuropatkin telegraphs there was a fight Tuesday at Da Pass between Bentaisputze and Simintzin.

The Japanese attempted to capture the pass and the Russian left flank but were repulsed.

The turning movement was checked by the Russian cavalry supported by machine guns.

The news of this advance of Japanese was caused on a false report in Tokio that Kuroki had crossed the Hun river twenty miles north of Da Pass.

The Japanese are not expected to assume a general offensive attitude there for some days.

GOODWINS CONVICTED


And Sentenced to the Penitentiary For Term of Two Years Each—Other Court News.

Late Tuesday evening Clarence and John Goodwin were found guilty of the theft of copper wire from the Perry coal mine, at Adamston, and were sentenced in circuit court by Judge John W. Mason to serve two years each in the penitentiary. For many months prior to their arrest the coal companies in this district had been losing copper wire and were at a loss to account for it, until the Goodwin boys were arrested. Probably in all \$2,000 worth of wire was stolen. The date of their arrest marked the cessation of this sort of theft and there seems no doubt that they did a good part of it at least and that the arrests deterred others thus
