NEW LAWS

On the Tax Question Are To Be Printed and Circulated at State Committee's Expense.

It has been a favorite Democratic lie that the Republicans were afraid of the new tax legislation and studiously suppressed discussion of the subject. Every one who knows anything of the campaign knows that charges utterly false, but in order to bury it beyond hope of resurrection the Republican state committee has ordered 5,000 copies of the Acts to be printed at its own expense, to be distributed among the voters of the state through the Republican county committees. They will be ready within ten days, and will be sent broadcast by the state committee into every county in the state from Hancock to McDowell and from Jefferson to Wayne. Every one desiring a copy should put in his application to the county committee and they will be freely furnished.

The state edition of the Acts has been exhausted, but in order to inform the people exactly what the extra session did the state committee decided on this course, having 5,000 copies printed at its own expense.

The Acts will be distributed in addition to the large amount of literature on the tax question already put out and will certainly smash the Democratic canard to a pulp.

In the Salem district, this county, the South Penn Co. has drilled its No. 5 on the Samuel Gain farm into the top of the Gordon and the hole has filled up 100 feet with fluid.

On the east side of the Folsom district, the South Penn has drilled its No. 2 on the F. V. Mason farm 30 feet into the Gordon and has a show for a very light pump. The same company has drilled its No. 2 on the Jesse Talkington farm 10 feet into the stry and has a light gas pressure, but no oil.

In the same district, No. 3 on the Mary Moore farm is holding up at 150 barrels a day.

On Rummel's run, Clay district, Ritchie county, the McKelvey Oil Co. has drilled its No. 4 on the Ben McElhinis farm through the Spaw sand and has a show for a 10 or 15 barrel pump.
