PETITIONS ARE BEING CIRCULATED

In the Different Wards of the City For Subscription By Property Owners Protecting Against Sale of the Water Works System.

Petitions protesting against the sale of the city water works plant are being circulated for the purpose of securing signatures in the five wards of the city to be presented at the next regular session of the city council when disposition of the offer of Reese Blizard to buy this system for \$100,000 will be made. The petitions are all alike and read as follows:

"The undersigned citizens and tax payers of the City of Clarksburg desire to protest against the proposition to make sale of the city water works plant. We can see no reason for any such action at this time and believe it to be hostile to the best interests of the people of Clarksburg. If this plant can be operated at a profit by a private company there is no reason why the city cannot do the same and we cannot believe that your body would approve surrendering it to a private concern for \$100,000, a plant which has cost the tax payers of Clarksburg much more in dollars and cents, exclusive of the franchise itself. We respectfully urge that no such action be taken."
