SHINNSTON, Feb. 1.—(Special) "Suit against partnership" is the title of a very important bill that has been referred to the judiciary committee.

Sec. 1. A partnership carrying on a trade or business in this state, or holding property therein, may be sued by any name which it has assumed, or by which it is known; and in such case it shall not be necessary to allege or to prove the names of the individual members thereof.

Sec. 2. Any notice or process against a partnership sued by its company name, shall be served and returned as provided by existing laws relating to the service of notice and process upon natural persons, except that such service against a partnership may be made by leaving a copy thereof at its usual place of doing business in the absence of a member of the partnership thereat, with any person over the age of sixteen years in charge of such place of business, and explaining the purpose of the process to him, or such service may be made as to such partnership by service thereof upon any member of the partnership; and any service so made, shall be good and effective as to the partnership and its assets and property, provided, however, that any judgment or decree rendered under this chapter shall be enforceable and binding upon the firm property, partnership assets, and against the separate property of such of the partners as shall have been served, and one or more executions may issue thereon.

Sec. 3. Nothing in this act contained, shall impair or take away the right to institute any action or suit for or against a partnership, in process or notice thereon; or any the manner and subject to the rules existing prior to the passage of this act; nor shall this act affect any proceeding or judgment or decree that would have been proper in such suit or action; provided, however, that when in any action or suit or proceeding brought under this act or otherwise, a judgment or decree is rendered against any one or more of the members of a partnership on account of a debt, liability or cause of action against the partnership; then, and in any such judgment or decree and execution thereon, shall bind and be issued against the property and assets of the partnership, and also against the individual partner or members of the partnership, as to whom the court shall have acquired jurisdiction by process duly executed.

Hawkins, who conducted an experiment yesterday on killing two cats in the death parlor at the Elosser home by carbon monoxide gas poisoning, had concluded that Grace Elosser and Charles E. Twigg had accidentally met death in that manner from the gas stove.

State's Attorney Robb says he will not accept the report of the doctors in the gas theory as final, and claims the mystery is as deep as ever.

The doctors in the autopsy and in the chemical analysis say they feel more assured than ever after the experiments of the last two days that cyanide caused death.
