

## NEW APARTMENTS AT BROADDUS FINE

**Mr. Johnson Has Transformed Buildings into Fine Rooms and Halls.**

The Broadbuddus apartments, owned by Charles D. Johnson, are being taken rapidly now, since their completion within the last few days. Mr. Johnson has transformed the buildings into one of the most desirable apartment houses to be found anywhere. He has spent \$12,000 in converting the buildings into apartments and the transformation is not only pleasing to the eye but the appointments are most convenient and comfortable.

The location is a pleasant and highly respectable one, being near the splendid Mulberry residential section of the city and within a few minutes' walk to street cars. The apartments have good sidewalks and paved streets most of the way leading to them from the business sections of the city and a foot bridge spans Glen Elk, making them easily accessible from Glen Elk and the railroad station. The buildings have wide yard space around them and the highest elevation in that section of the city. The drainage is perfect both by nature and artifice. Another important feature is ample shade for every apartment in the buildings. Cement walks have been laid around the entire premises and an old-fashioned water well drilled through solid rock conveniently provides water for drinking and cooking purposes. The water is of the very best quality. All these exterior features as well as others make the place one of the most delightful spots in the city. There is no need to seek farther for a pleasant home-like place, indeed, there are but few home-seekers who would care to pass Broadbuddus by after seeing it.

The Broadbuddus apartment buildings consist of three floors and a basement. The floors are divided into four apartments or seventy-eight rooms in all besides the two big laun-

dries in the basement. The buildings are so arranged that when apartments are made, it is necessary. Every apartment has a big private porch arranged for convenience and comfort. The ceiling of the first floor rooms is twelve feet high and it is ten feet high on the other two floors. The hallways as well as the stairways leading to the upper apartments are wide and the many other hallways in the buildings are amply wide and so built as to have exposure at both ends for ventilating.

The rooms are of convenient size and have ample doors. The smallest rooms are twelve by sixteen feet and the largest ones sixteen feet by twenty. Clothes presses and private bath rooms are found for every apartment. The apartments are convenient as to the number of rooms running from two to seven, and are therefore desirable for small or large families.

A complete and comprehensive steam heating system has been installed by the Pittsburg Steam Heating Company and a Rudd instantaneous hot water system has been put in. Every apartment is separately wired for electric lights and especially piped for gas.

The porches and the greater part of the interior of the buildings are all new. The plastering is new and the wood work has been newly painted. The walls are thick thus cutting off sound between the apartments. Every window is to have a good oil blind and there are various other furnishings.

Mr. Johnson takes great pride in the new apartment house and hopes to make it the most popular one in the city by giving it prompt attention and service. He will cheerfully show home-seekers through the buildings, if they call at his home at 120 South Chestnut street, or call him on Bell telephone 861-J. E. C.
