GASOLINE NOW A BIG PRODUCT

Industry is Marvelously Developed in West Virginia Oil Fields.

SISTERSVILLE, Oct. 21.—Many persons are not aware that the coming oil field industry, the production of gasoline, had its origin in this city. This is true nevertheless, and at this time practically all of the better grade of gasoline is produced in the Sistersville and nearby Tyler county oil fields. If Tyler county's production of gasoline should fall entirely within the next twenty-four hours there would be a hue and cry among both dealers and consumers that would reach from Maine to California.

The production of gasoline is largely the result of accident. The first man to start a gas pump on an oil well to increase the production was to a certain extent the first producer of natural or casing head gasoline. Without the gas pump, a gas line leading to the casing head of an oil well produces little or no gasoline, but as soon as a vacuum is put on that line a fluid begins to accumulate. In warm weather very little gathers in the lines, but in cool weather there is considerable of it, and in cold weather it gathers in such quantities as to obstruct the steady flow of gas for operating purposes and often in conjunction with water the line will freeze up and cause all manner of trouble. This obstruction and freezing, naturally leads to drips in the line. This fluid was drawn off and for a time allowed to run to waste. Later on the gasoline was separated from the water and used in motor engines that the owners had little respect for. These engines to the surprise of their owners, seemed to develop power and show remarkable wear. Gradually the stuff was tried in better grade engines with good results and now the motor field, when he wants to set the road on fire, fills his tank with 76 casing-head gasoline before he starts.

The market for casing-head drip developed very slowly. In 1905 the first steel drum filled with casing-head drip was shipped from Sistersville, W. Va. Later in the same year the first tank car was shipped. This car was filled with rolling steel drums up an incline skid way and their contents dumped into the car through the top of the dome. The trade grew gradually and in 1909 the demand was beyond the supply. Orders would come in for from five to ten drums and the customer would get one or two with the instructions to pray for good weather, so the production could be increased.

This demand led up to good prices and good prices led up to the use of the compressor to assist the gas pump and increase the output. The development of the gasoline business since the advent of the compressor has been to say the least marvelous. In 1905 the total amount of drip gasoline produced and saved in the Sistersville field was in the neighborhood of 1806 barrels. We are producing more than that now in one week, and the end is not yet. The casing-head gasoline business has come to the front and made history faster than any other commercial business that history gives any record of. Even one year ago the home product was despised and slandered and dangerous as being worthless and dangerous. And now it is sought after as being the best cold weather motor fuel known to the trade. It has the indorsement of the best chemists in the world. It has also been passed on by the bureau that regulates the shipping of all dangerous articles and it has been given a clean bill of lading by that bureau. Casing-head gasoline is a great and valuable product.

When a gasoline producer sells 38 quarts of gasoline at home he gets from seven to eight cents per gallon, and has to pay thirty cents per gallon for 76 quarts when he is on a trip in his motor. This shows, as in most other productions, passing through the hands of "middlemen" that there is too much of a "rake-off" before the consumer is reached. Of course there is considerable cost by leakage and evaporation in handling gasoline, but for all that it is apparent that the producer as well as consumer are being worried. They should be nearer together on the price.

Sistersville is the hub of high grade gasoline for commercial use. Commercial gasoline ranges between 63 and 86 gravity. Below 63 it is too heavy to vaporize readily enough for motor use and above 86 it is too light and generates too much pressure on the ordinary gasoline tank. A very small percentage

of 86 is made from crude oil. It is the first run of the still which will condense at atmospheric pressure and is the highest gravity that can be economically used at such pressure. Gasoline is made in all the oil fields from Pennsylvania to Oklahoma. It varies in quality and quantity according to the sand formation from which it is produced. The quality is governed more particularly by the pressure at which it condenses.

Here in Sistersville, where the best gasoline in the world is produced, it is made right around 100 pounds pressure. Leave Sistersville and go twenty miles in any direction and the pressure ranges from 130 to 300 pounds. Gasoline at these higher pressures is too volatile for commercial use at the present time. It has to be kept in air tight containers of special manufacture and used from them above atmospheric pressure. The time is not far distant, however, when these higher gravities will be sought after for light and heating purposes, for which it is especially adapted.
