iron mills, the potteries, the glass factories and other like industries of this section, but never a word did he say about them. Instead, he launched into generalities, gave an academic digression as to the benefits of education, and closed with an appeal for support in the usual platform manner.

This dodging of the vital questions in which the people of Clarksburg and its vicinity are interested, met with a chilly reception and it was clearly evident from the attitude of the audience and the remarks heard here and there that voters were sorely disappointed with the abstractions with which the speaker had taken up most of his time.

While Governor Wilson declined to comment on Roosevelt's statement that the Democratic nominee ought to continue stumping regardless of the attempted assassination, it was announced by Wilson today that he would make no change in his plan for the rest of the campaign. Wilson is firm in his intention to close his speaking campaign tomorrow night when he speaks in New York.

Democratic oracles heralded the glad tidings that special trains from all directions would bring in the multitudes and there was a fond expectation of at least 20,000 auditors. The Sutton train actually brought seventy-two, a special from another direction brought sixty-two or sixty-three and no more. The train from Parkersburg gathered the crowd up along the line and landed 129 here.
