BRAXTON

County Coal Sold to Pittsburg Broker for Investment Purposes.

UNIONTOWN, Pa., Jan. 10.—Purchased about six years ago by J. O. Clark, the Uniontown real estate dealer, coal in Braxton county, W. Va., has been disposed of at four times the original price. The purchaser is Edwin Bricknell, a coal broker of Pittsburg, who will hold the coal for investment purposes. It is probable that he will purchase other coal lands in that section if they can be secured at a reasonable price.

Mr. Clark made his first venture in Braxton coal about seven years ago. He purchased the 400 acres which figured in yesterday's deal about four years later for \$10 an acre. He still owns a large acreage of coal in that portion of West Virginia. Although not positively known, it is believed that an attempt will soon be made to develop the coal of Braxton county.

The block of coal disposed of to Mr. Bricknell is about two miles from the town of Braxton on the Baltimore and Ohio railroad. The coal is near the central part of West Virginia, near the Elk river.

The deal between Mr. Clark and Mr. Bricknell has been pending for about ten days. The final papers were signed yesterday in Uniontown.

It is reported that other Pittsburg men are after coal in that section of West Virginia, and other large deals can be expected in the future.
