## DECISIONS

Are Handed Down by the Supreme Court of West Virginia.

CHARLESTON, Jan. 23.—Judge Ira E. Robinson has handed down his dissenting opinion in the case of the state, et al., L. A. Mays, vs. M. L. Brown, warden of the penitentiary, and others, as well as that of S. F. Nance against the same defendants. The opinion is a very lengthy one.

Judge Robinson some time ago refused to concur in the decision of the other four members of the court in which martial law was sustained, as well as the right of the governor to create a military commission, and empower them to try and sentence persons other than members of the state militia.

One of the important cases filed was an appeal from the circuit court of Wayne county—the Hill Clutch Company vs. the Independent Steel Company of America. The suit involves about a quarter of a million dollars on the question of a mechanics' lien.

The following opinions have been handed down:

Hansen vs. Devoney, from Marion county, affirmed.

Smith vs. White, et al., from Mingo county, reversed and remanded.

Hertzog vs. Riley, from Taylor county, reverse and cause remanded.

Milon & Sons vs. Gratton Gas & Light Company, from Taylor county, demurrer overruled and cause remanded.

Clayton vs. Clayton, from Barbour county, reversed and remanded.
