MAY DROP CASE

Former Parkersburg Attorney Arrested for Embezzlement May Never Face Trial.

PARKERSBURG, Feb. 11.—That the case of R. H. Moon, a former local attorney who was arrested in Los Angeles, Calif., last September and brought back here to answer three indictments for embezzlement of funds which he had collected as an attorney, will never be tried seems probable. He was arraigned in the criminal court here yesterday, and the state again had the case continued because of the absence of material witnesses.

The George H. Bassett Company, of Cleveland, O., whose funds Moon was alleged to have embezzled, failed to send any one here to prosecute the case. Moon was a prominent worker in church circles here and held high positions in several secret societies.

HONORARY

Degree is Conferred on the Pastor of Baptist Church at Buckhannon.

RICHMOND, Va., Feb. 11.—Trustees of Richmond College have voted to confer the honorary degree of doctor of divinity upon the Rev. J. W. Cammack, pastor of the Baptist church at Buckhannon, W. Va., from 1906 to 1910, during which period a fine new church was built under his ministry. Mr. Cammack is one of the youngest ministers ever thus honored by Richmond College. He graduated from the Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, at Louisville. For the last three years he has been filling the post of associate editor of the Religious Herald, a Baptist publication of this city. Richmond College, of which he is also an alumnus, confers only two of these degrees annually.

Governor Glasscock has exerted every effort to bring about a solution of the chaotic conditions which exist in the strike zone. He has been zealous in every respect, but has not, I am sorry to say, had the support that he was entitled to receive, and the disposition on the part of those aggrieved made his task more arduous.

An expense of two hundred and ninety thousand dollars has been incurred and no amicable settlement has been reached. Nothing will bring about a state of anarchy quicker than infringement on the rights of man. So these matters must be thrashed out and radical changes made in order that oppression may be eliminated and the equal rights given to all.

GRAFTON, Feb. 11.—The dead body of E. J. Burton, a Baltimore and Ohio railroad brakeman, was found stretched out upon the top of a box car of a west bound freight train between Thornton and Newburg.
