FORGER LANDED FOR TWO YEARS

Said to Be a Man of Education and Prominence.

About three months ago an expert check worker caught a string of banks in West Virginia, two banks in this city, one in Parkersburg, one in Wheeling and various others being victimized, it is alleged. The Burns detective agency was engaged, with the result that shortly afterward a man named Francis St. Clair was arrested at Williamson, as he was on his way to Marietta with a woman companion, the arrest and St. Clair's exploits being given in the Telegram at the time. The following from the Wheeling News of Saturday evening is the sequel:

"Francis St. Clair, alias St. Clair McKay, alias James Percival, a

young man of neat appearance, well educated and expert penman, was sentenced this morning by Judge Allen Robinson in criminal court to serve two years in the Moundsville prison on his plea of guilty to forging checks on local banks. St. Clair's life from the time that he was a lad at school in Scotland reads like fiction. His parents, prominent Scotch Highlanders from the northern part of Scotland, gave their son an excellent education and when he became of age he received \$10,000 in money as his portion of his parents' estate. He decided to come to America and make a fortune. The pictures that were put before him of the land of the free induced him to come to New York City.

He came to this country and received a position with a large corporation that netted him \$350 a month. The large salary was his downfall. He was induced to mingle with high society and as a result got in wrong with wine and fast women. He traveled the pace that kills for a number of years and in that time spent his entire fortune and lost his job. He came to West Virginia and started new, but soon again went to the bad, with women as the direct cause. He forged checks on many banks to assist the women who held strings on him. He got in with a prominent woman of this city and went on a trip down the river. The Burns detectives were put on the trail and with the local detectives found out who the woman was. They trailed her to the home of a relative at Williamson, W. Va., where she was arrested. In the meantime St. Clair had left for other parts and the sleuths were unable to locate him.

After hearing that the woman he was responsible for getting into trouble had been arrested, he gave himself up at Parkersburg. Since being kept in the county jail he has been a model prisoner and as he is a wizard with the Bible he has taught some of the prisoners to lead better lives. When the ex-convict evangelist of Charleston was in this city some time ago St. Clair was one of his first converts. He was represented by Attorney Gail Hamilton, who made an eloquent plea for a minimum sentence. He stated that
