Is Called by the Mayor to Settle Ice Men's Strike in Cleveland, O.

CLEVELAND, O., July 15.—Fear that the strike of ice delivery men will become general led Mayor Baker to announce today that he will call a meeting of union officials and ice manufacturers to put an end to the controversy.
Forty city ice delivery workers struck today in addition to the 100 Colonial Ice Company men already out. The strikers want an increase from \$17.20 to \$20 a week and a six day week.
