WILSON FORCES IMPERIOUS WILL

Upon a Reluctant Congress Declares Senator Oliver of Pennsylvania.

BOSTON, Feb. 20.—"In my opinion one of the great mistakes of our time lies in the constant and increasing incursions of the executive upon the legislative domain," Senator Oliver, Republican of Pennsylvania, told members of the New England Women's Press Association, pleading for "reasonable progressivism as against reckless radicalism—constitutionalism against socialism and anarchy."

"I am reflecting on no particular party," Senator Oliver added. "Each is alike culpable. The abuse began under President Roosevelt, was continued under President Taft and is present under President Wilson. It is the present executive who has brought it to full maturity in forcing his imperious will upon a reluctant Congress."

Senator Oliver reviewed the progress of the woman suffrage movement in this country. It was within the range of probability, he said, that women would be granted suffrage throughout the United States within ten years, although he thought no action would be taken by Congress upon the pending constitutional amendment.

"Please understand," he said, "that I am not taking sides on this question. I merely mention these things to show that the public mind is agitated upon it. It is likely that you women will before long have a voice, perhaps the controlling voice."

in the decision of public questions; and it is with a view of directing your minds along these lines of right thinking on such questions that I venture to say a few words in behalf of a reasonable progressivism as against reckless radicalism—of constitutionalism as against ultimate socialism and anarchy. The lines are being drawn between these two contending ideas and the women of the country may shortly be called upon to take their stand upon one side or the other.

"The constitution is a document filled with concessions and surrenders. The right of making laws the people delegated to Congress, the duty of constructing them to the judiciary, and the administering of them to the executive—all of these rights and duties, however, to be exercised within the limits prescribed in the constitution itself.

"It is now proposed by the advocates of the new democracy that the people in a large measure should resume many of the rights thus voluntarily surrendered. They would have the laws enacted by popular vote, instead of by representatives chosen for that purpose, and, what is of even greater import, they would have the people constitute themselves the court of last resort by reserving the right to overturn any judicial decision which in their momentary anger they see fit to resent.

"But the all important concession involved in the adoption of the constitution was the surrender by the

people themselves of the right of hasty action. They had the power to offer the law—fundamental or otherwise—when and how they pleased; but in adopting the constitution they surrendered this right so far as the fundamental law was concerned and agreed to amend it only in the manner prescribed in the instrument itself.

"I have great faith," he said, "in the common sense of the American people; and when any question of importance is submitted to the judgment of that common sense we can be reasonably sure of a right decision. The great difficulty is so to arouse the people that they will exercise their common sense. The people may sometimes lend a listening ear to the demagogue and turn their back on the sage; but give him the time to think and the arguments of the sage will in the end prevail.

"Constitutional limitations—the restrictions in the fundamental law of both state and nation which force us to act, and law-makers to legislate, with certain prescribed limits—are what compel the people to think before they act, and when they do act to have a due regard for the rights of each other. The written constitution protects us alike from the despot and the mob.

"Discard the written constitution or compromise it, or allow it to become a dead thing in your hands and the day will surely come when property rights will be no more regarded—when commercial might will

make a right and when they will have not will by sheer force of numbers take what they want from this that have."
