GO TO CHURCH!

ODD FELLOWSHIP IS VERY ABLY REVIEWED

By Former State Senator Samuel B. Montgomery in Address at Kingwood.

KINGWOOD, April 27.—Members of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, of Preston county, under the auspices of Kingwood Lodge No. 107 assembled last evening in the Methodist Episcopal church to observe the ninety-fifth anniversary of the founding of the order in America. Senator Samuel B. Montgomery delivered the address, which was in part as follows: Every member in Odd Fellowship should know the history of the second oldest fraternal institution in the world. In order that he may be able to inform the public of the character, objects and importance of an institution but little known to them, and could be no more appropriate time to review the history of this institution than on this occasion.

The legal title of the present body is the Sovereign Grand Lodge of the Independent Order of Odd Fellows, and as such we are incorporated under the laws of the state of Maryland. The Sovereign Grand Lodge is the source of all true and legitimate Odd Fellowship in the United States of America, and possesses such powers and jurisdiction over the whole Brotherhood as are provided in the constitution and ritual of the order. The grand lodges of Germany, Australia, Denmark, Sweden, Switzerland and South America, which are independent, yet are governed by the Sovereign Grand Lodge which retains the power to guide, control and keep all laws, usages and customs of the order uniform throughout the globe.

Early History of the Order.—Great Britain. The order has been in existence but a few years, not exceeding two hundred at most. Its birth was in Great Britain early in the eighteenth century. Laboring men from the mills, factories, mines and quarries banded together for social intercourse to help one another secure employment and to extend the hand of charity when in need.

Owing to political conditions then, secret societies were not viewed with favor by the government and this caused the closing of many lodges, while all the members were compelled to conceal their lodge affiliations.

However in 1813 a remnant of the faithful formed what is known as the Manchester Unity, which is the parent body of the American order.

American Order.—On the 27th day of March 1819, the following advertisement appeared in the "Baltimore American":

NOTICE TO ODD FELLOWS "A few members of the Society of Odd Fellows will be glad to meet their brethren for the purpose of forming a lodge, on Friday evening, April 2nd, at the Seven Stars, Second street, at the hour of seven P. M."

The brother who had this notice inserted was Thomas Wilkey, and on the 26th of April, 1819, five brothers self-instituted Washington Lodge, and the first lodge of American Odd Fellowship was thus launched.

The first charter was issued from the Duke of York's Lodge, England, a few months later, which charter was also used in the establishment of the first grand lodge and the Sovereign Grand Lodge.

Membership Today. The report for the fiscal year of 1913 showed a grand total of 1,645,369, not including 231,866 members of encampments, and 711,873 members of Rebekah. In our own state the last annual report shows a membership of 26,326.

Relief. The total revenue of the Sovereign Grand Lodge for the year just closed, was \$18,928,758.38.

The total expenditures for the same period were \$5,317,323.15, thus leaving a surplus of thirteen million dollars.

The brothers deceased numbered 145,601, and the families of deceased brothers, numbering 7,063, shared in the distribution of \$3,901,000.

"Ninety-five years ago! How lightly the words fell from our lips, but how vast and wonderful have been the changes in the destinies of the world and the human race. Within this period which tells the history of our nation and of our order, have been wrought the mighty wonders which must forever separate the future from the past. Think of the advances made in every avenue of human endeavor and every development of knowledge. Man has literally harnessed the powers of nature and attached them to his conquering chariot wheels. He has subdued the elements, reared into the clouds, abstracted the lightning and coaxed it to turn the wheels of commerce; light his pathway; carry his voice from city to city; cable his imperial commands from sea to sea and catch his distress signal in the clouds in mid-ocean and flash it to a life-saving station on shore.

The pioneer fathers were sheltered from the storm by the rudely built but hospitable log cabin. The rising sun of the 19th century was far from the golden belt of the East, the beacon of promise, to all Odd Fellows, before his powerful rays penetrated the lone lodge and warmed and cheered its five humble members.

Civilization was primitive and was only reflected by the dim light of missionary zeal, patriotic fervor and how to be quickened into more potent flame and glory by the torch of fraternalism, whose mighty rays, ignorance, illiteracy, indolence and superstition was to give way, and the wilderness made to smile and blossom by the thrift, enterprise and intellect of the early settlers as they threw off the yoke of oppression, stupidity and weakness of the old world and caught the adventurous spirit planted by the pioneer.

A New Civilization. Here in America we are building an improved civilization indeed a new civilization as America became the melting pot of all old countries and all people.

What has Odd Fellowship contributed to the moral empire? What are its fruits? Cast your inquiring eyes upon the broad and beautiful expanse of our own country. Whenever a people have been neglected, to remote, however distant or fraught with hardships and perils as the wilderness passes from chaos to order, do our temples lift their spires and Odd Fellowship give its aid to the great transition.

The fathers of American Odd Fellowship were the pathfinders of American fraternal, benevolent and secret societies. By fidelity to the principles of the order, with perseverance and unremitting toil they struggled on overcoming all obstacles until the now traveled great international highway of Odd Fellowship which reaches every short and long reaches every clime.

World-wide in its scope. A work of such magnitude is not the reward of a day or generation, but it is for all time, for all people and for all humanity.

The world is our parish and worldwide is our invitation to the children of men and even in the remotest corners of the earth go our workers.

An elemental moral force marked in men and not susceptible to change without destroying him is a feeling for companionship, the feeling for association with his fellow man. It is the feeling vital to progress, that our order seeks to cultivate; the feeling when cultivated expresses itself in the sentiment of brotherhood.


