ARE TO STUDY METHODS IN WEST VIRGINIA

Federal Department to Investigate Road Building Systems in Seven Counties.

WASHINGTON, D. C., May 18.—Detailed studies of local road building systems in one hundred counties are now being carried on by the Department of Agriculture in cooperation with state highway departments and local authorities.

The purpose of this study is to defects in existing local methods of building and maintaining roads which will aid the state authorities to put local road management on a systematic basis.

This investigation is prompted by the fact that there is at present very little knowledge as to the most effective and economical methods by which a county can develop its roads.

No Standard System. There is, moreover, at present no standard system of keeping accounts for road building and maintenance, and as a result, while some counties know to a penny the purpose for which money was spent, others have no definite check or reporting system.

In connection with the scientific study, the department's highway engineers will advise freely with local officials as to improvements, and thus give each county visited the advantage of direct co-operation, engineering supervision and assistance.

NEW CHART

Of the Delaware River Shows All Recent Changes in Shore Lines.

WASHINGTON, D. C., May 18.—The United States Coast and Geodetic Survey, Department of Commerce, has published under date of April, 1914, a new chart, No. 296, of the upper part of the Delaware river from Philadelphia to Trenton.

A draft of twelve feet can now be carried to Bordentown, the entrance to the Delaware and Raritan canal, and beyond, through an improved channel to the wharves of Trenton.

The chart contains a sub-plan of the vicinity of Trenton on a scale of 1-20,000. Soundings are in feet at mean low water and heights in feet above high water.

THE BLOUSE DISTINCTIVE.




An unusually pretty blouse in satin batiste, having a vest of all-over lace and sleeves cut in one piece. It is one of the latest French models.

quires as much care, if not more, than the construction. The outer front back and sleeve are laid on an open width of the batiste, along a lengthwise thread. The neck edges of the front of the lining may be cut away for any desired outline, but popular fancy seems to favor the V shape.

Now close the under-arm and sleeve seams of the outer blouse and sew up the center back seam. Gather the lower edge of the waist-lining and adjust the stay. A cord covered with the waist material is now sewn over the gathers at the front to give the effect of cable shirring.
