

Angel Gonzalez, offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:

Whereas this corporation is indebted to Francisco Alvarez in the sum of four hundred and fifty dollars, which sum is secured by a deed of trust upon the casino lot and building but is not otherwise indebted, and it is desired that this corporation sell its property and discontinue this corporation, and

Whereas the Board of Directors have an offer of five thousand dollars for the village of Grassell, Harrison County, West Virginia, and belonging to this corporation.

Therefore be it resolved by the stockholders of this corporation assembled at their last known place of residence, and at which meeting there is present 454 shares of stock in person or by proxy, the same being a majority of all the capital stock of this corporation, that the Board of Directors be authorized and directed to accept the offer of five thousand dollars for the said lot and casino building, and to execute by the president of this corporation the purchase of said property.
