



NEW BATTLE LINES DIFFER FROM OLD IN WEST DISTRICT

According to interesting Bulletin Issued by the National Geographic Survey.

WASHINGTON, April 29.—The National Geographic Society has issued from its headquarters in Washington an interesting bulletin on the area, population and noteworthy features of the territory which lies between the present battle line on the western front and the line marking the crest of the Teutonic invasion, which swept down through northern France toward Paris. The bulletin says:

"A survey of the trench lines in Northern France, while the opposing armies spend their strength in a titanic struggle around the fortress of Verdun, affords an opportunity to compare their location with the line, which the onswearing Germans gained in their 'farthest south' and 'farthest west' marches toward Paris and Calais, during the early months of the war.

"The present line of contact compared with the old, shows its first variation in a small loop at Arras. In the first rush the Germans overran this thriving capital of the province of Artois, but subsequently they were pushed back, just beyond the city.

Large Triangle.
"Moving due south in the survey, the next divergence of old and new lines embraces a large triangle of which the ancient city of Amiens is the western apex. A few miles west of the River Oise the two lines again converge and coincide until Soissons is passed, then there is a long deflection to the west, showing that the Germans at one time reached Creil, a prosperous town of 10,000 inhabitants on the banks of the Oise, to the south of Compiègne. This is the section where the Germans have lost the greatest amount of territory which they held in France during the early stages of the war, for it was in this drive down the Marne valley that the point nearest Paris was reached. Among the regained cities in this region the most important, of course, is Rheims.

"The old line and the new coincide again some fifty miles due east of Rheims and a few miles west of Verdun. The final bulge of the old line over the present trenches occurs at a point almost directly east of Barle Duc and takes in a thin slice of the Meurth-Moselle valley, including the important town of Lunéville, the birthplace of Francis of Lorraine, who became Emperor Francis I. of Austria, and the founder of the present reigning family of the dual monarchy by marrying the Archduchess Maria Theresa early in the eighteenth century.

"Roughly measured, the territory regained from the Germans in France exceeds 2,500 square miles, or considerably more than the area of the state of Delaware. Its population before the war was in the neighborhood of half a million.

Famous Ceremony.
"Within the redeemed area are some of the most interesting places in France, notably Rheims, the place

of coronation for most of the kings of France, since the beginning of the Capetian dynasty. The most famous ceremony of this character to take here was, of course, the anointing of Charles VII, after Joan of Arc had driven the English from before the city walls. It was here, too, that Clovis was baptized on Christmas day, in 496. Before the devastation wrought by the present war, the great Rheims cathedral was considered by many critics of architecture the most beautiful structure produced during the middle ages.

"Amiens, with a population of 90,000 before the war, is next in importance among the salvaged cities, its cathedral, one of the most imposing piles of Thirteenth century architecture in Europe, was scarcely less famous than the one at Rheims. It was in this city that Peter the Hermit, the great preacher of the first crusade, was born. Since the war, Amiens' noted woolen, silk, cashmere and velvet manufactures have suffered greatly.

"Arras, also reclaimed, was noted for its woolen manufactures before the war. In medieval days its tapestry hangings were so famous that the name of the city was adopted as a common noun for draperies in England. Maximilien Ropespierre, the revolutionist, was born in Arras, also Joseph Lebon, who conducted the 'Terror' with great cruelty in his native city.

"Other retaken towns are: Villers-Cotterets noted as the birthplace of Alexander Dumas; Chateau Thierry, famous for the manufacture of mathematical and musical instruments, and as the birthplace of the great writer of fables, La Fontaine; La Ferte-sous-Jouarre, whose quarries supply many of the millstones of France; La Ferte Milon, the birthplace of the great dramatist, Racine, and Commercy, where many American tourists have stopped to buy a box of the delicious cake known as 'Madelines.'"
