TORTURE OF ARMENIANS. Forced by the Turks to Sign an Address of Thanks to the Sultan.

LONDON, ENGLAND, May 7.—The Evening News today publishes advice from its correspondent at Kars, saying that 800 of the survivors of the recent massacre in Armenia, who returned to their homes under promise of protection from the Turks, have been daily persecuted and tortured at the hands of Turkish officials, supported by gendarmes.

For two months, it is added, the officials have tried to force the refugees to sign an address of thanks to the Sultan, stating that they met with only kindness at the hands of the troops, that all the troubles were caused by the Turkish raiders and the Sultan's troops took no part in the slaughter.
