SUMMARY OF THE MARKETS.

Silver firm. Gold market steady. Wheat freight steadily held. Wheat going down again. Barley steady. Corn dull at the decline. Rye quiet. Fair call for flour. Cotton products lower. Oilcake weak. Hay in ample supply. Beans irregular. Coffee continuing dull. Potatoes and onions plentiful. Butter, cheese and eggs steady. Vegetables quiet. Lemons scarce and firm. Wine grapes still higher. Prospects for dried fruit improving. Hops neglected. Almonds and walnuts selling well. Some changes in lard. Provision trade improving. Butter declined in price. Tallow unchanged. No sale for wool. Wool very dull. Good movement in canned fruit. No change in oils. Lumber expected to advance again. Market largely nominal.

CHICAGO MARKETS.

CHICAGO, Ill., Oct. 2.—A remnant of yesterday's weakness of wheat was brought forward to this morning's opening. The first few moments, as is usually the case, were fairly active, but all the week disappeared from the market very early in the session. Wednesday is generally scarce of news and speculators dislike to trade unless there is some information to incite them.
