The makers claim that it is the only steam shovel on the market which is suited to trench sewer digging. The shovel will dig a trench from four to twelve feet in width and from one to fitteen feet in depth. It has a capacity of 800 cubic yards in ten hours. The material may be deposited at either side of the center at any distance up to fourteen feet. The dipper will swing ten feet from the level of the ground upon which the shovel stands. Its weight is forty-six tons.
