THE CONTRACT NOT LET YET.
Shipping Men Are Creating a Fund for the Relatives of the Drowned Men.

The fate of the British ship Blairmore is still unsolved. Just who will attempt to raise her has not been decided upon and the five wreckers that put in bids are still on the tenter hooks. All the parties concerned met in the office of Catton, Bell & Co. yesterday afternoon and offers ranging from \$22,000 to \$30,000 were opened.

The bid was the highest and the lowest bid was rejected. Lloyd's agents, Healy, Tibbitts & Co. would drive cluster cables around the ship and by placing cables under the hull would raise it bodily. In order to be sure of their premises the firm had a pile-driver sent in Mission Bay yesterday testing the resting power of the mud. The California Wrecking Company is backed by the Risdon Iron Works and the chances are that if they secure the contract the work of raising will be done by tugs.

Nearly all the contractors stipulate that they will raise and dock the ship within sixty days, but if they succeed inside of three months many an old sea captain will be agreeably surprised. Strange to say, the bid of the Union Iron Works for the raising of the Earl of Dalhousie was \$22,000, but then the company lost over \$15,000 on the transaction.

The Supreme Court Sustains a Decision by the Los Angeles Court.

The act of the Legislature passed March 17, 1891, providing for the issuing of bonds to defray the cost of street improvements where the cost exceeds \$2 a front foot, has been declared valid by the Supreme Court.
