


THE COMMERCIAL WORLD.

Summary of the Markets. Seventeen failures last week. Silver lower. Australian coal very scarce. Wheat still dull. New barley sold at 70c. New Italy, 62 1/2c. Oats steady. Corn dull. Hay unchanged. Potatoes and onions unchanged. Butter, cheese and eggs weak. Tomatoes lower again. Truckery higher. Ducks and young poultry weak. Peaches and figs lower. Apricots still higher. Berries in heavy stock. Straws, struts unchanged. Watermelons received from Arizona.

The Week's Reports. The Bradstreet Mercantile Agency reports 17 failures for the Pacific Coast States and Territories for the week ending July 3 as compared with 12 for the previous week and 17 for the corresponding week of 1895. The failures are divided among the trades as follows: 1 fruits, 3 to 10, 1 hardware, 2 drugs, 2 liquor, 1 not on our list, 1 horse-drawn, 1 shoemaker, 1 lumber, 1 marble and masonry, 2 savings banks, 1 general store.
