

LIVELY DOINGS OF NON-PARTISANS

They Find Some Trouble in Nominating Supervisors.

Matters Are Not Mended by a Secret Session of Over Two Hours.

JAMES D. PHELAN IS GRATEFUL

R. H. Webster Gets the Nomination for Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Mum was the word at last night's session of the Citizens' Non-Partisan Convention.

All went well until the nominations for Supervisors were called for. Then the mystery commenced amid much clamor and confusion, and finally all but the delegates were excluded.

L. R. Ellert, chairman of the committee on Supervisors, presented the following names:

Ernest Denicke, chairman of the committee on Board of Education, reported in favor of the nomination of R. H. Webster as Superintendent of Public Instruction.

Mr. Le Breton reported in favor of the re-nomination of the following-named City Officers: Recorder, J. Glynn; Sheriff, Richard L. Whelan; Public Administrator, A. C. Freese; Coroner, W. J. Hawkins, and M. C. Haley for County Clerk.

Barclay Henley introduced James D. Phelan, the convention nominee for Mayor, who was received with cheers.

Nominations for Supervisors were then called for. Mr. Ellert moved that the rule requiring a two-thirds vote be dispensed with. This caused some controversy.

Matters speedily assumed a threatening aspect, but at length, after much speech-making, it was decided to go into executive session for the purpose of passing upon the merits and demerits of the proposed nominees.

Just before the public and press representatives were excluded from the hall Mr. Denicke presented the following list of candidates for nomination to the office of School Director:

When, after nearly three hours of waiting, the doors were opened an attempt was made to proceed to the nomination of Supervisors.

Frank J. Sullivan moved that the list be voted on as a whole. This called for a storm of opposition and the list was taken up serially. The uproar was indescribable. Lawrence Devany's friends seemed at one time to have secured his nomination, but the cheering "pushing through" was raised, and the convention proceeded to review the other names.

Mr. Van Peit was strenuously opposed by supporters of Dr. Leitanz, while the name of L. J. Truman was shouted down by friends of Dr. Clinton, who seemed very much in the minority.

No hope appearing that any practical result could be gained, and it being already midnight, the convention adjourned until this evening, the entire matter of Supervisory nominations being postponed until then.

NON-PARTISAN BOSSES. Scheme to Secure Another Democratic U. S. Senator—Republicans May Bolt.

There is lack of harmony in the Non-Partisan Convention on the proposition to nominate or endorse candidates for the Senate and Assembly. It was understood by many of the appointed delegates—among those who had acted with the Republican party on State and National questions—that the convention would not go further than the nomination of a municipal ticket.

The impression is very strong that Frank Sullivan, who is J. D. Phelan's brother-in-law, and Barclay Henley, of the Non-Partisan string in the beginning to help Phelan. Now there is a growing suspicion that Democratic aspirants for the United States Senate are seeking to manipulate affairs so as to prevent the Republicans from gaining the Legislature. The pretext advanced for interfering in the contest for the Legislature is that pledges to support the new charter are demanded in the event of that instrument going before the Legislature.
