SAN JOSE, CAL., May 20.—The Board of Trade is working assiduously for the improvement of Alviso harbor, and in the next few months some definite action regarding Santa Clara County's assent will be taken.

At present the steamer Alviso makes daily trips between San Francisco and half a dozen teams are engaged in hauling freight between the port and this city.
