STANFORD NOW MOURNING

Smith From Palo Alto Surprises the Talent in the Events of Yesterday.

The sixth annual intercollegiate field day has come and gone, and the same expressions are seen on the same faces.

A majority of 50 points makes a soul-stirring victory for the winners and quite a funeral affair for the conquered.

Many were the occasions for California explosions, and persistent cheering by a criterion by which to measure the amount of happiness that fills the human breast.

Drum, now a sophomore in the University of California, was the star whose athletic radiance bedimmed all others.

Out of fourteen events Stanford won but three first places and tied California for first honors in two field events.

Two or three performances were noteworthy. Broughton established an intercollegiate record in the broad jump.
