DUBLIN, Aug. 27.—This has been what is known as a horse show week in Dublin. Only to those who know what the annual Dublin Horse Show is and what it brings in its train will this phrase convey its full meaning.

In 1820 King George IV.—"the last of the fools and oppressors called Avast," as Byron called him in his "Irish Avarice"—became patron of the society, and thenceforward it became the Royal Dublin Society.

This phenomenal success—phenomenal that is, for Ireland, where so many things have gone to the bad under English rule—has undoubtedly due to the superiority of the Irish-bred horse.

The soil and climate of Ireland are peculiarly suitable for producing first-class thoroughbreds and hunters, as has been shown by the success of the yearlings, especially on the English turf, and accordingly no such collection can anywhere be had in Europe as is now to be seen every year at Ballsbridge of the colored sires, thoroughbred mares and thoroughbred colts and fillies.
