A small steamer for use on the Colorado River is being built at the foot of Third street and will be in use in a few days.



NO MONEY TO THE CREDIT OF THE DEPARTMENT.

Funds Will Begin to Come in Next Month, but He Refuses to Anticipate Them—\$225,000 Borrowed Already.

No bills of any description against the School Department will be paid during the present administration.
