Discovery City Is Almost Deserted. RUSH TO THE HEAD OF ATLIN.

RICH STRIKE REPORTED IN A NEW DIRECTION.

Many Who Left to Locate Claims Took Very Little Food, and Are Now Said to Be in a Very Perilous Position.

JUNEAU, Alaska, Dec. 31 (via Vancouver, B. C., Jan. 4).—Discovery City, in Atlin, was at last accounts utterly deserted except by the butcher, the baker, the candlestick maker and a few others who couldn't get away.

This last strike is reported as being over in the direction of the Taku trail coming from Atlin. Just where the new strike is not yet known here, but the trail is up Pike River from Atlin, to Pike Lake, and then over a range of low mountains.

Reports continue to reach the coast favorable to Otter Creek. A man came down to Discovery on Pine Creek recently with about \$500 in coarse gold, which he said he had taken out in two weeks on Otter Creek.

Considerable number is being whipsawed for sluice boxes by men who have claims on the several creeks. Cabins are also being built and notwithstanding it is almost the dead of winter there is considerable activity around Atlin City and Discovery River.

Part of the caravan which left Lake Atlin last fall has arrived at Atlin after a terrible experience. Particulars are not yet obtainable here. They are very hungry and forlorn-looking lot of travelers. The horses are poor and the men are half starved.

Another storm is raging in Southeastern Alaska and the mail ships are greatly delayed. As soon as the weather moderates the first large party of the season will leave Juneau for Atlin on the Taku trail.
