LOST THIRTY DAYS IN A FOG

BARK WOOLAHARA'S LONG VOYAGE ACCOUNTED FOR.

Schooner Charles Hanson Pooped on the Eureka Bar—Reinsurance on Two Overdue Ships Jumping.

The American ship M. P. Grace and the British bark Brussels have just completed two of the longest voyages that have been made between Australia and San Francisco in years.

The Brussels left Newcastle, N. S. W., on November 20 last, and after getting off shore had continuously dirty weather from the north and northeast to latitude 5 south.

The Grace and Brussels were so long out that reinsurance was paid on both of them. It was not heavy enough to tempt the gamblers, however.

The British bark Woolahara, which arrived at Eureka the other day, gave her account of her long voyage.

The schooner Charles Hanson, which left here over a week ago for Eureka, had a hard time of it crossing in over the Humboldt River bar.

Reinsurance on the British bark Carnarvon Bay and ship Alcides is going up with leaps and bounds.


