EARLY CROPS DAMAGED. EFFECT OF THE RECENT COLD SPELL ON THE MARKET. The New York Commercial says: "The effects of the cold wave upon all descriptions of early crops are being felt more and more every day. They are chiefly noticeable in the continued scarcity and bad condition of the early crops. The weathering has reached the distributors here."

FRUIT AND SALMON IN ENGLAND. Californian fruits are moving off briskly at firm rates, says the London Gazette. The market for the spot will be augmented by 40,000 cases which have arrived by the Panama this week. Practically the whole of the California produce is being shipped to London.
