CONSULTS MCKINLEY AS TO ARMY COMMISSIONS AND APPROVES THE PHILIPPINE POLICY.

CALL HEADQUARTERS, WELLINGTON HOTEL, WASHINGTON, July 8.—Under the roof of the White House as the guest of President McKinley, Governor Roosevelt of New York reiterated to-night his confidence in the re-election of his host, gave warm approval to the administration's conduct of the Philippine campaign and its policy with respect to volunteer appointments, and scored the anti-imperialists for giving aid and comfort to the enemy.

Governor Roosevelt's trip to Washington was made by direct invitation of the President to discuss with the chief executive the question of the distribution of commissions among the men of his command during the Spanish war and the volunteers of the National Guard of New York.
