HULDA HAS A FOAL BY SEARCHLIGHT

A. B. Spreckels' Grand Race Mare Produces What Should Be a Speed Marvel.

A. B. Spreckels, the master of Aptos Stock Farm, is the proud owner of a fine bay colt foaled at Aptos last Wednesday. The youngster is out of Hulda (2:08 1/2), one time queen among American trotters, and is by the great pacer Searchlight (2:03 1/2). Hulda's last foal was by Dexter Prince, and died from the effects of an operation when it was but a few weeks old. Hulda is twelve years old and was bred by Mr. Spreckels. She was raced on the Big Eastern circuit in her four-year-old form and also the following season. On her first racing pilgrimage she started four times, carrying off first honors each time, returning with a record of 2:14. The following year her owner set his heart on winning the Columbian free-for-all at the World's Fair, Chicago. Prior to this meeting the great race mare started at Buffalo, Detroit and New York. She met the fastest horses in America and defeated them.

DOG SHOW DATES.

The annual meeting of the San Francisco Kennel Club was held on Monday last and was the best attended and most enthusiastic in the history of the club. Those present were: Adolph B. Spreckels, the president; John E. de Ruyter, secretary; J. C. Barrett, treasurer; N. H. Hickman, H. H. Carlton, J. P. Norman, W. S. Kittle, James L. Flood, who was elected to membership on the occasion; Leon S. Greenbaum, Joseph L. Spingler, Dr. J. W. Skiffie, Dr. K. O. Steere, F. P. Butler, M. M. Tomkins, C. Brown and many others. The election of a board of directors resulted as follows: John E. de Ruyter, A. B. Spreckels, J. P. Norman, J. L. Spingler and L. S. Greenbaum. The date for the annual bench show was set for May 2, 3 and 4, in McAllister Pavilion. The bench show committee was then selected, as follows: N. H. Hickman, H. H. Carlton, J. P. Norman, W. S. Kittle, C. Brown and Leon S. Greenbaum. After the meeting of the club the directors met and elected officers for the coming year, as follows: President, Adolph B. Spreckels; first vice president, John E. de Ruyter; second vice president, Joseph L. Spingler; secretary-treasurer, Henry H. Carlton; acting secretary and acting treasurer, J. W. Skiffie. Every indication is that all records will be broken from a financial standpoint as well as in the matter of entries, at the club's bench show. The Verona Kennel's noted collie Champion Heather Mint has been distinguished herself again, having won first prize in the open class at Providence, R. I., as also the winner's prize. The Pacific Coast special committee of the American Kennel Club held a meeting at the Occidental Hotel recently, at which William N. McCarthy's protest was considered and finally determined. Mr. McCarthy amended his original complaint by alleging that R. M. Dodge, the handler of Sam's Bow, which beat Farand for the second time, had won the prize by reason of infractions of the rules of the bench show committee. Mr. McCarthy in his amended complaint alleged that Mr. Dodge had removed his pointer from the bench and had exercised him during forbidden hours. The case was referred back to the San Francisco Kennel Club for rehearing, but as the appellant failed to bring evidence in support of his case, the committee emphatically repudiated the allegation, the San Francisco Kennel Club remanded all cases back to the special committee for decision. The committee decided that Mr. McCarthy had not shown sufficient reason for a reversal of the judge's decision, and his appeal was therefore denied. J. P. Atkins of Alameda, the well-known cocker spaniel breeder, has been elected to membership in the San Francisco Kennel Club.

She also holds the Wallace trophy. The secretary, treasurer and port captain have all held their offices before and proved themselves thoroughly efficient. J. V. O'Brien has directed the many entertainments given by the club for several years, and W. S. Grover is the owner of the yawl Arcturus, which sailed in every club cruise of last season. Carl Westerfield, the retiring commodore, read his annual report, in which he made a suggestion that early in the season a challenge for the perpetual cup should be sent in to the present holders, the San Francisco Yacht Club, and that the challenge should be issued in a class in which the defenders are strong rather than one in which they are weak. This sentiment is a sportsmanlike one and it is believed that the members will be glad to accept it. The secretary's annual report stated that there are now in the club 203 members, who own 35 sloops, 11 yawls, 1 schooner, 6 launches and about 75 small boats. Treasurer Barrett's report showed that in spite of the numerous entertainments and heavy expenses of 1899 the revenue more than equaled the expenditure. Much interest is manifested in the club contests and a brilliant season is anticipated.
