GERMANY HAS GIVEN RUSSIA MANY REASONS

Declares the Withdrawal of Troops From Peking Would Prolong War. Situation in China Continues Difficult in Diplomatic Sense Rather Than From Military Standpoint.

BERLIN, Sept. 8.—The numerous cables arriving serially, putting to Germany compromise propositions in answer to the Russo-American proposals, appear useless.
