WITNESS SAYS HOFF CARRIED LEAD PIPE Declares He Saw Coupling Pin in Defendant's Carpet Bag.

Accused Man Nervous When He Reads Account of Murder in Paper and Suspicion Falls on Him.

The second trial of Albert Hoff, charged with the murder of Mrs. Clute on December 15, 1897, is dragging on so slowly in Judge Carroll Cook's court that yesterday his Honor announced that in the future until the close of the case the court will open at 9:30 in the morning instead of 10 o'clock...

The first witness yesterday morning was L. W. Decker, a wholesale cigar salesman. He was in the grocery store at Turk street and Van Ness avenue about 7 o'clock in the morning the day after the murder of Mrs. Clute. When he entered the barroom in the rear of the store Hoff and several other men were conversing in front of the bar. The witness heard Hoff say, "I am very sorry; she was a very nice lady, and this affair puts me in a bad light and I am walking out."

Henry Diercks, one of the proprietors of the grocery store at Turk street and Van Ness avenue at the time of the murder, was the next witness. He proved a very poor witness. He saw Hoff on the morning of December 16 and testified that Hoff read the newspapers about the murder in his store and that the newspaper shook him up a good deal...
